Ghost Hunting Kits Available at Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library

WHAT:

Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library (BVMPL) recently added four Ghost Hunting Kits to its collection with donated funds after receiving multiple requests from patrons, just in time for the Halloween season.

Each kit includes the most common and popular ghost hunting equipment such as an EMF meter, EVP recorder, and motion sensor, as well as books about ghost hunting and paranormal accounts in North Dakota. Adult patrons may check out one kit per library card for seven days.

"Ghost hunting kits engage Bismarck's patrons with entertainment and imagination," said patron John Kinney. "The kits also cultivate the library's presence as a lifelong knowledge provider, increasingly important to an educated population."

BVMPL promotes lifelong learning and personal enrichment opportunities by offering its patrons a wide range of collections, services, and resources on a variety of topics and subject matter.

In addition to the Ghost Hunting Kits, BVMPL circulates other unique collections, such as board games, pickle ball sets, art prints, fishing poles, and ND State Park passes. These collections are referred to as "Library of Things," items available for check-out that expand the definition of traditional library materials and further meet patrons' educational and entertainment interests.
