What to know about North Dakota Early Childcare Services Law and the North Dakota Smoke Free Law

(NDCC 50-11.1-02.2)

- ✓ No smoking, vaping, or e-cigarette use in indoor areas where smoking/vaping is prohibited and on the premises.



- ✓ Post "No smoking" signs clearly at all entrances.
- ✓ Communicate to all employees and visitors where smoking is prohibited.
- ✓ Remove ashtrays from any area where smoking is prohibited.
- ✓ No smoking, vaping, or e-cigarette use in the work vehicles.

- ✓ Adopt the North Dakota Dept. of Health Tobacco-free Childcare Model Policy.
