

WASTE COLLECTION

- **City issued trash cans** must be set out by 6:00 am on your scheduled pickup day.
- All garbage must be bagged.
- Place your trash cans at the end of the driveway.
- There must be a **distance of 4 feet** between trash cans, mail boxes, light poles, or vehicles.

Containers may be placed out for collection 12 hours before and must be removed within 12 hours after collection.

NOTE: Please place the container back from the street during sweeping and plowing seasons. It is very helpful for our City street maintenance workers.

- Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is not allowed in garbage collection containers. Bismarck residents can bring it free of charge to the HHW & Recycling Center at the Landfill.

YARD WASTE

- **Drop-Off sites** are available April thru October (*weather dependent*). Refer to the Garbage Collection Map for locations.
- No animal waste, plastic bags, or branches are allowed.

NOTE: In 2025, 5,100 tons (or 10,200,000 lbs) of grass and leaves were collected and composted.

SINGLE-SORT RECYCLING

- Dumpsters located at the entrance of the landfill and available **free** of charge. Available during Landfill hours of operation.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE & ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

- **Valid ID** required when disposing of any HHW or Electronic item.
- Stop by scale house for disposal instructions.
- Open: **7:00 AM to 3:00 PM**
Monday through Friday; and
9:00 AM to 2:00 PM
1st and 3rd Saturday of every month



- Free drop off for Bismarck residents living within city limits.
- Fees apply to non-residents & businesses.
- Commercial hazardous waste is not accepted.



Re-use Room:

Open during HHW hours of operation.

UPDATED GARBAGE RULES (2026)

Effective January 1, 2025, all trash placed out for collection must be **inside** the trash can.

If you have any extra trash you will need to utilize one of the following options:

1. Take the extra trash to the landfill yourself. *Regular Landfill fees will apply.*
2. Pay for a 2nd trash can. There will be a \$50.00 delivery/service fee for each extra can requested, it will require a 12-month commitment plus a monthly fee of ½ the rate of your monthly collection fee.

BULK ITEM PICKUP

Back by popular demand—If you have a bulk item such as a stove, refrigerator, bed, etc. that you would like to dispose of, you can call Public Works Service Operations to be placed on the Bulk Item collection schedule. A \$25.00 service fee, along with the cost to dispose of the items at the landfill will need to be prepaid at the time the request is made.

EX: \$25 service fee + cost of items

SELLING RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY

If a property is sold, all city-issued trash cans remain with the property.




How to Find Your Pick-Up Day

Garbage: Pick-up days are outlined in **Red, Purple, Teal,** and **Blue.**

Recycling: Pick-up weeks are shaded on the map in **Green** and **Gold.**
